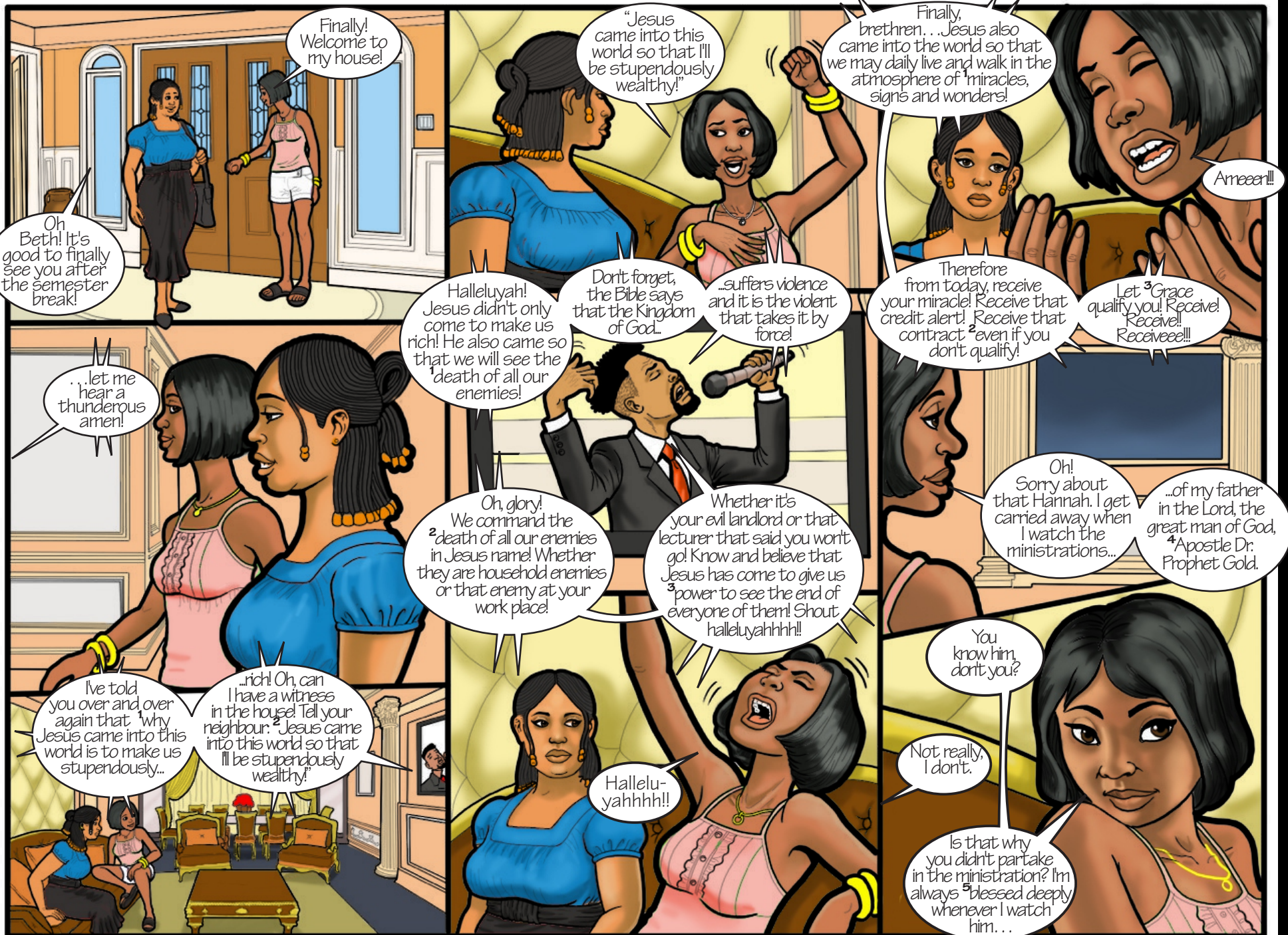

However, we need to continue our discourse. I now need to list the most important reasons why He came into this world.

Are you saying there are more reasons apart from all what you've taught so far? Even the ones you've mentioned and explained are ²treasures I'll still need more time to ³prayerfully ⁴study and understand...

I don't want you to have ⁶incomplete knowledge and revelation of the truth, that's why... and if you remember, you'll recall that I said there are primary and secondary reasons why the Lord Jesus came into the world...

That's true...

I've only listed and explained the secondary reasons Jesus came into the world—we're still left with...

...the primary or most important reasons why the Lord Jesus came...

Please, do let's go on...

There are primary reasons the Lord Jesus came into this world to die for our sins. I'll list them and explain them one by one.

Okay.

The first primary reason why he came into the world to die for us is this: To put our

¹Old Man to ²death and the second primary reason is this: To ³redeem us by His precious ⁴blood so that

He can have a ⁵total man—spirit, soul and body, that He can ⁶indwell as His ⁷temple & ⁸live...

...His own life in ⁹us in fulfilling His own purpose in ¹⁰furtherance of the Kingdom of God.

Now I'm not sure I understand again o... what is 'My Old Man' and the other things you've said? I've gotten it up to the point where you...

...explained all the secondary reasons... however, these primary reasons are quite unclear...

Remember I promised to explain each point one by one... so let's begin with the first primary reason.

I said the original or primary reason why Jesus came was to put our ¹Old Man to death.

The 'Old Man' is simply the ²spirit, ³nature and ⁴power of the devil that is actively ⁵working in men of disobedience—this spirit, nature and satanic power has equally dominated mankind...

...since the fall of man. It is known by so many names yet it is the same person, or personality. It is sometimes called the ⁶'Old Man', the ⁸old nature, the ⁹flesh, ¹⁰Sin, the ¹¹old self...

...carnal man, the ¹²human nature and so on... however, it is the same personality—¹³Satan himself, the ¹⁴prince of the power of the air and the ¹⁵spirit that is now actively at work in the sons of disobedience...

...you see, when man ¹⁶fell into sin and he became ¹⁷separated from God, the Spirit of God

also ¹⁸departed from man—for God does not and cannot dwell where there is ¹⁹sin therefore, man became ²⁰exposed and defenseless...

...and his submission to Satan's temptation and falling into sin has put him in an untenable position—he has now ²¹exchanged masters.

Where God was the Person ruling him before, Satan is now the one ruling and falling into sin has put him in an untenable and...

...controlling him. Thus, the spirit, soul and body of all men were now ²²dominated by satanic powers until Christ came into the world to die for the sins of man, in order to redeem mankind.

When Jesus came into the world through a ¹virgin birth, He lived a perfectly ²sinless life and all the while, Satan was conspiring to kill him through ...

...the high priests, Pharisees and the scribes what Satan never ⁴knew however was that, in the mysterious, multifaceted ⁵wisdom of God, the very ⁶purpose of Christ...

...was to come and die a ⁷substitutionary death for mankind so that by allowing Satan to kill him, Satan will utterly ⁸ruin and destroy himself—in that, since he put Christ [whom he has ⁹no authority...

...or rights over], to ¹⁰death and by so doing, through...

...Christ, Satan has now ¹¹lost all authority and all rights over every man whom he previously had power...

Wao... This is serious!

Since the Old Man had so ¹²mixed himself with man such that there's no way of separating one from the other, what Jesus did was to take man's place ¹³in suffering & death such that our Old Man was ¹⁴co-crucified...

...with Jesus so that our body of sin was destroyed! So, everyone who looks to His ¹⁵sacrificial death by ¹⁶faith won't only die to (ie. separated from) his 'Old Man' & old life, but will also ¹⁷resurrect with Jesus by faith...

...to ¹⁸a new life—the very ¹⁹life of Christ, which begins ²⁰in that man and all the power of Satan is now ²¹perpetually & permanently destroyed!

So, as one who has accepted the sacrifice of Christ, you too are ²²dead—and in place of the old, a new life begins and a ²³New Man now lives in you!

wait... did you just say I'm dead?

Yes. If you're ¹truly born again, you're ²dead. I didn't say you will die or you may or you could die... the Bible says ³you have died—and that's the ⁴absolute truth... that's the reality!

How is this so?

It's because since the Old Man is ⁵irredeemably hopeless & can't be ⁶reformed or ⁷improved upon—⁸for he who's in the flesh ⁹can't please God, and since God Himself...

...doesn't want improvement but a ¹⁰total replacement; therefore in His manifold ¹¹wisdom, He decided to...

...put the Old Man & the ¹²fallen man—(ie. his human vessel), to death by including ¹³mankind in the ¹⁴crucifixion and death of the Lord Jesus Christ...

You said in ¹⁵dealing with the Old Man, God doesn't want improvement but instead, He wants a total replacement.

If I may ask, how do you mean?

Good question! Satan is a ¹great deceiver... you see, in order for him to remain relevant, once people become saved or decide to...

...be more serious with God as a Christian, ²Satan encourages them to keep ³improving as they go to church and read the Bible...

Since ⁴nothing has changed within—as they're still ⁵carnal and the true way into spiritual freedom in Christ and total victory over the devil is through ⁶death. So, instead of dying so that they can enter into ...

...true ⁷spiritual liberty & ⁸total victory over Satan, he encourages them to be more dutiful to God by keeping ⁹rituals like going to...

...church more, joining a service group in church, giving & trying more and more to please God but there's a problem with rituals...

Which problem is that? Because all what you just described really sounds like ¹⁰me...

You see, rituals has another name—¹religion! And God isn't ²looking for religion... He is looking for a ³restoration of that ⁴personal and ⁵intimate ⁶relationship with God that was ⁷lost in Adam. More so...

..., what religion ALWAYS focuses upon and constantly emphasize is endless ⁸improvement—and religion is a ⁹satanic ploy to keep men in an ¹⁰endless and hopeless cycle of delusion called 'improvement'.

Hmmm... I've learnt so much in just a short time and I'm very grateful... but I still have more questions and I'm actually ¹¹hungry for more. What about this exchange of life and a total replacement? Can you explain further?

Yes, I can. You see, it's a ¹²life for a life, i.e. when we come to believe in Christ, we must be ready to accept that we're ¹³dead to our ¹⁴old life and to our ¹⁵old master—Satan...

...now be the ¹⁷person that dwells within us—the resurrected Lord Himself! Just as the Old Man is the spirit and nature of the devil...

...and in exchange for that old, godless life, we now receive the ¹⁶New Man—the Lord Jesus Christ! He will...

Thus, it's the resurrected Lord Jesus who now ⁷demand to displace the 'old you' so that He can ⁸replace your old life with ⁹Himself! This is the ¹⁰mystery of Christianity—the resurrected and glorified ¹¹Christ, living, talking, walking, praying etc. in you, that's the hope of glory!!

...the ¹New Man is the ²spirit and ³nature of the Lord Jesus Christ who now dwells in us. Thus, the Lord, who will not accept any 'improvement of life' (where we'll keep changing little by ...

...little), instead, He ⁴demand a total replacement—where our Old Man & old lifestyle is totally ⁵displaced our & New Man & a ⁶new life totally replaces the old life!

Wao...! The ¹²resurrected Christ Jesus will be **living in me!** ¹³I've never heard this before!!!

That's the ¹⁴truth! This is why the Bible says: ¹⁵We have this treasure in an earthen vessel so that the excellency of the power may be of God and not of us!

The Lord Jesus Himself—He is that ¹⁶Treasure within our human spirit, for everyone who ¹⁷belongs to Him!

Don't forget: ¹Christianity & the ²Christian religion are two totally different things. Christian religion is a hopeless, endless delusive cycle of improvement based on human idolatry.

...but **Christianity** is the ³means through which God ⁴restores His relationship with man that was...

...lost in Adam through the sacrifice of our Lord Jesus Christ and what it offers is an ⁵exchange of life & ⁶a total replacement!

My final point on why Jesus came is this: To ⁷redeem me by paying the price of His precious blood so that He can have a ⁸body that will not only belong to Him... but also ⁹exclusively...

a ¹⁰human spirit He can ¹¹indwell as a temple & live ¹²His own life in this my body.

By ¹³redeeming us, He now ¹⁴owns us completely and totally—¹⁵spirit, soul and body! This means that we are ¹⁶exclusively His property... thus, He now not only has a ¹⁷legal right to be on the earth, He equally has...

...a human ¹⁸spirit He ¹⁹dwells in and a human ²⁰body He works through.

This is the ²¹primary reason Jesus came into the world.
