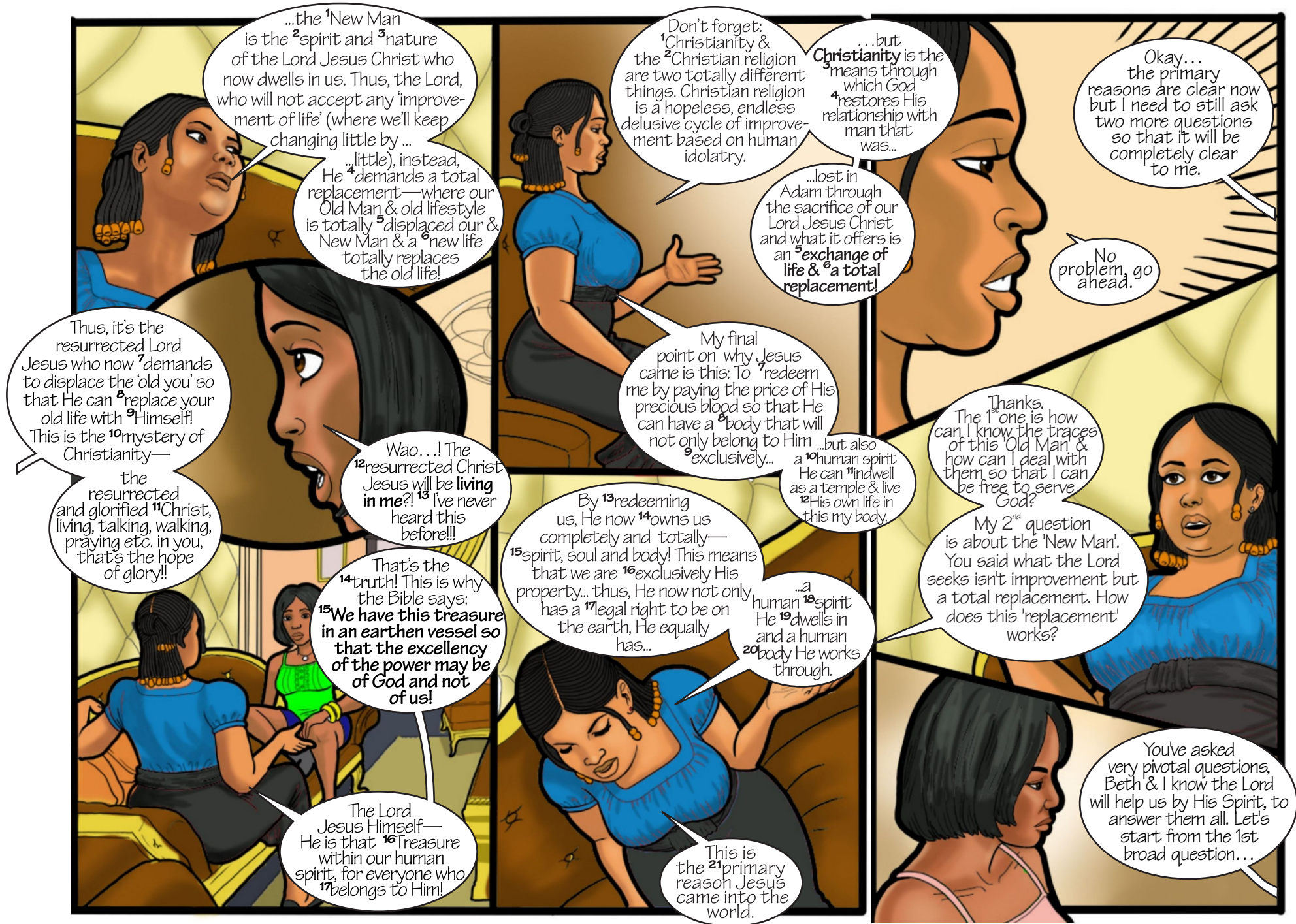


THE PRIMARY & SECONDARY
REASONS WHY
JESUS
CAME **PART 2**





...the ¹New Man is the ²spirit and ³nature of the Lord Jesus Christ who now dwells in us. Thus, the Lord, who will not accept any 'improvement of life' (where we'll keep changing little by ...

...little), instead, He ⁴demands a total replacement—where our Old Man & old lifestyle is totally ⁵displaced our & New Man & a ⁶new life totally replaces the old life!

Thus, it's the resurrected Lord Jesus who now ⁷demands to displace the 'old you' so that He can ⁸replace your old life with ⁹Himself! This is the ¹⁰mystery of Christianity—

the resurrected and glorified ¹¹Christ, living, talking, walking, praying etc. in you, that's the hope of glory!!

Wao...! The ¹²resurrected Christ Jesus will be **living in me!** ¹³I've never heard this before!!!

That's the ¹⁴truth! This is why the Bible says: ¹⁵**We have this treasure in an earthen vessel so that the excellency of the power may be of God and not of us!**

The Lord Jesus Himself— He is that ¹⁶Treasure within our human spirit, for everyone who ¹⁷belongs to Him!

Don't forget: ¹Christianity & the ²Christian religion are two totally different things. Christian religion is a hopeless, endless delusive cycle of improvement based on human idolatry.

...but **Christianity** is the means through which God ⁴restores His relationship with man that was...

...lost in Adam through the sacrifice of our Lord Jesus Christ and what it offers is an ⁵exchange of life & ⁶a total replacement!

Okay... the primary reasons are clear now but I need to still ask two more questions so that it will be completely clear to me.

No problem, go ahead.

My final point on why Jesus came is this: To ⁷redeem me by paying the price of His precious blood so that He can have a ⁸body that will not ⁹only belong to Him exclusively...

...but also a ¹⁰human spirit He can ¹¹indwell as a temple & live ¹²His own life in this my body.

By ¹³redeeming us, He now ¹⁴owns us completely and totally— ¹⁵spirit, soul and body! This means that we are ¹⁶exclusively His property... thus, He now not only has a ¹⁷legal right to be on the earth, He equally has...

...a human ¹⁸spirit He ¹⁹dwells in and a human ²⁰body He works through.

Thanks. The ¹one is how can I know the traces of this 'Old Man' & how can I deal with them so that I can be free to serve God?

My ²question is about the 'New Man'. You said what the Lord seeks isn't improvement but a total replacement. How does this 'replacement' work?

This is the ²¹primary reason Jesus came into the world.

You've asked very pivotal questions, Beth & I know the Lord will help us by His Spirit, to answer them all. Let's start from the 1st broad question...

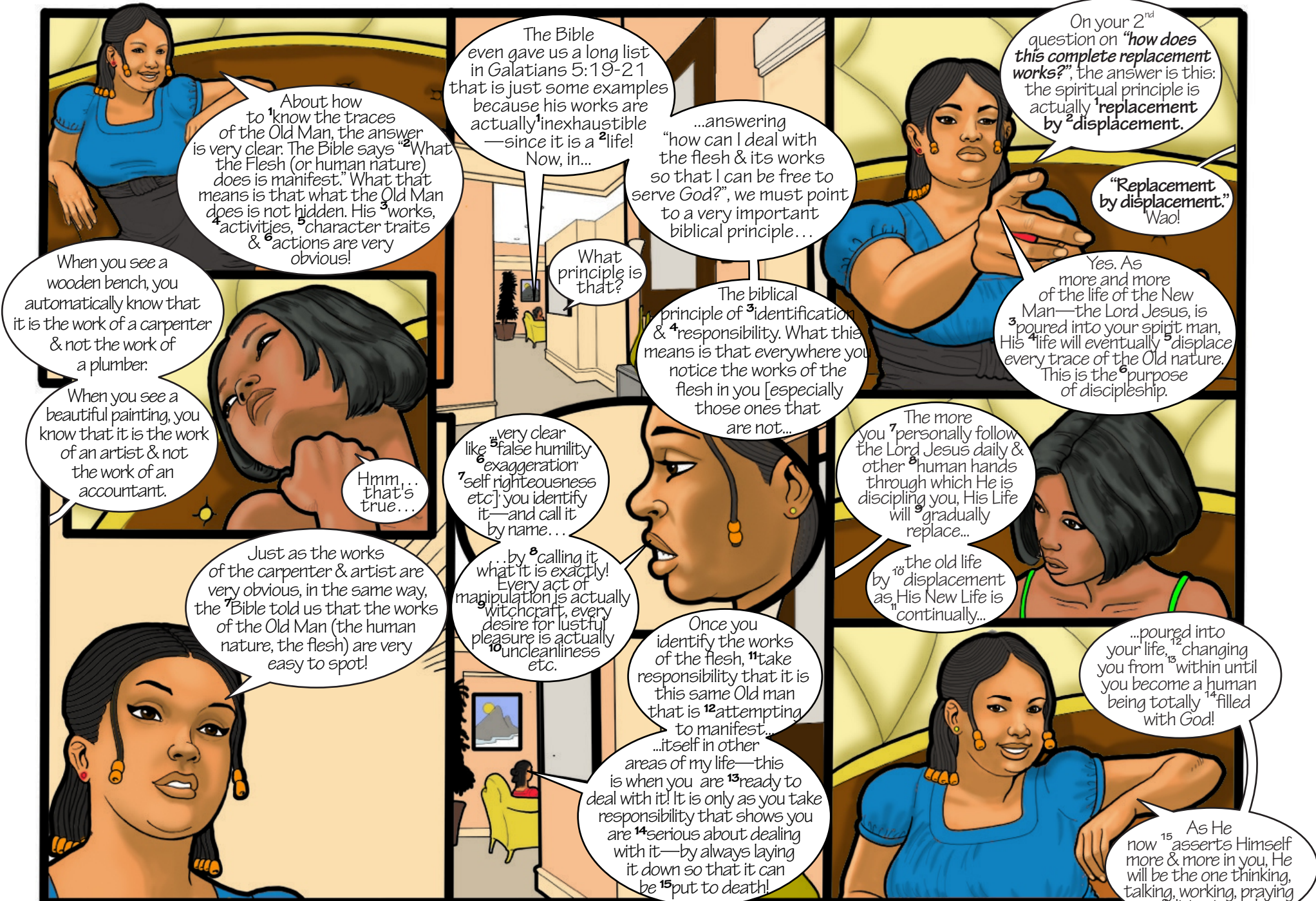

About how to ¹know the traces of the Old Man, the answer is very clear. The Bible says ²“What the Flesh (or human nature) does is manifest.” What that means is that what the Old Man does is not hidden. His ³works, ⁴activities, ⁵character traits & ⁶actions are very obvious!

When you see a wooden bench, you automatically know that it is the work of a carpenter & not the work of a plumber.

When you see a beautiful painting, you know that it is the work of an artist & not the work of an accountant.

Hmm... that's true...

Just as the works of the carpenter & artist are very obvious, in the same way, the ⁷Bible told us that the works of the Old Man (the human nature, the flesh) are very easy to spot!

The Bible even gave us a long list in Galatians 5:19-21 that is just some examples because his works are actually ¹inexhaustible —since it is a ²life! Now, in...

What principle is that?

...answering “how can I deal with the flesh & its works so that I can be free to serve God?”, we must point to a very important biblical principle...

The biblical principle of ³identification & ⁴responsibility. What this means is that everywhere you notice the works of the flesh in you [especially those ones that are not...

...very clear like ⁵false humility ⁶exaggeration ⁷self righteousness etc] you identify it—and call it by name...

...by ⁸calling it what it is exactly! Every act of manipulation is actually witchcraft, every desire for lustful pleasure is actually ¹⁰uncleanliness etc.

Once you identify the works of the flesh, ¹¹take responsibility that it is this same Old man that is ¹²attempting to manifest... itself in other

areas of my life—this is when you are ¹³ready to deal with it! It is only as you take responsibility that shows you are ¹⁴serious about dealing with it—by always laying it down so that it can be ¹⁵put to death!

On your ^{2nd} question on “how does this complete replacement works?”, the answer is this: the spiritual principle is actually ¹replacement by ²displacement.

“Replacement by displacement.” Wao!

Yes. As more and more of the life of the New Man—the Lord Jesus, is ³poured into your spirit man, His ⁴life will eventually ⁵displace every trace of the Old nature. This is the ⁶purpose of discipleship.

The more you ⁷personally follow the Lord Jesus daily & other ⁸human hands through which He is disciplining you, His Life will ⁹gradually replace...

...the old life by ¹⁰displacement as His New Life is ¹¹continually...

...poured into your life, ¹²changing you from ¹³within until you become a human being totally ¹⁴filled with God!

As He now ¹⁵asserts Himself more & more in you, He will be the one thinking, talking, working, praying & living in you!

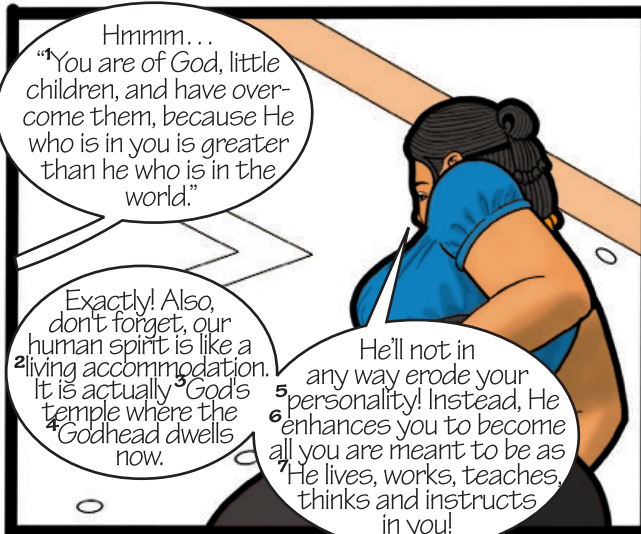
